Cell Pathway	Cytoplasmic vesicle, COPII-coated vesicle .
Tissue Specificity	Ubiquitously expressed. Highly expressed in testis and at lower levels in the submandibular salivary gland.
Function	domain:The BTB domain is required for interaction with CUL3.,function:Serves as a substrate-specific adapter for the CUL3-based ubiquitin-protein E3 ligase complex. Negatively regulates the Wnt signaling pathway via the targeted ubiquitination and subsequent proteolysis of DVL3.,similarity:Contains 1 BTB (POZ) domain.,similarity:Contains 6 Kelch repeats.,subunit:Component of an ubiquitin-protein E3 ligase complex which includes at least CUL3 and KLHL12. This complex interacts with DVL3 upon activation of the Wnt signaling pathway by WNT3A.,tissue specificity:Highly expressed in testis and at lower levels in the submandibular salivary gland.,
Background	This gene encodes a member of the KLHL (Kelch-like) family of proteins. This protein has been identified as an autoantigen in the autoimmune disease Sjogren's syndrome and as a potential biomarker in primary biliary cirrhosis. This protein may act as a substrate adaptor of the Cullin-3 ubiquitin ligase complex to promote substrate-specific ubiquitylation. Ubiquitylation by this complex has been shown to regulate the Wnt signaling pathway as well as COPII



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vesicle coat size. A pseudogene has been identified on chromosome 22. Alternative splicing results in multiple transcript variants. [provided by RefSeq, Dec 2014],
